

Residents that receive a Tree through North Beach’s Keep Maryland Beautiful Grant shall indemnify and hold harmless the Town of North Beach and its officials, employees and agents from any and all liabilities, judgments, settlements, losses, costs or charges (including attorneys’ fees) incurred by the Town of North Beach or any of its officials, employees or agents as a result of any claim, demand, action or suit relating to any bodily injury (including death), loss, or property damages caused by, arising out of, related to or associated with the KMB Resident Tree Project.

Requirements: Residents are responsible for contacting Miss Utility to locate a safe spot for planting within their property lines. Residents shall care for the Tree for at a period of at least one year, watering and mulching as suggested on the planting guide. Each resident that applies will get one tree or shrub, and coco disc to protect the tree as it grows. Residents will plant the tree themselves or can request volunteers from the Green Team to assist. Residents will share photos and allow photos to be taken of the plantings for documentation for the Town of North Beach’s Grant requirements to help with the success of the Keep Maryland Beautiful Project.
