## CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Boat slips were dredged to allow proper depth for boats. There are a total of 19 slips that are approximately 15 feet by 30 feet in size. The approximate depth at a normal low tide is minus four mean low water.
  - Living Shoreline was replanted in areas that needed it to make the shoreline compliant with MDE requirements.







# **CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS**

- Made repairs and adjusted grade for proper drainage on 8<sup>th</sup> Street from Greenwood to Frederick
- Installed new sidewalk on Dayton Avenue from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street; corrected some storm-water drainage issues; widened to provide parking on shoulder







## GENERAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Sunrise Garden was Bay-Wise certified
- Added Adirondack bench seating to Callis Park and Wetlands Overlook Park
- New electrical box covering on Bay Avenue
- Installed high water flood signs on
  Bay Avenue and Chesapeake
  Avenue











## **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS**

- Began repairs on 85 feet of seawall that was damaged by erosion from wave action
- Installed new stops signs throughout town
  DPW staff, Mark Dougherty, earned the Water II License and became a certified operator through MDE, which is required to operate the town water system


- Finalized proposal for Rental Housing and Code Enforcement software
- Follow ups continued on approximately seven properties that will now wait until weather breaks to be able to comply.
- Continued progress on abandon properties initiative. 6-month deadline will come Mid-April.
- Worked on and have proposals ready for parking enforcement suggestions and proposed enhancements to the rental inspection process.
- Working on and finalizing request for new budget.





#### FINANCIAL

- Community Legacy Grant Flood Protection Project
- State Bond Bill Flood Mitigation Project
- Net assessable real property base increased from \$236,788,653 on July 1, 2015 to \$237,230,967.
- The Town's Constant Yield Tax Rate of 0.6325 per 100 of assessed value was not adopted.
  The Town kept the same tax rate of \$0.6337 per 100 of assessed value.
- Trash Rate remained the same at a \$295.00 annually.
- Sewer Benefit fee remained the same at \$221.20.
- Water Benefit fee remained the same at \$110.10.
- Minimum quarterly water and sewer bill remained at a rate of \$148.20.






