## **Administrative.**

The Community Conservation Department was formed and the director of eco-tourism was hired. Standard Operating Procedures were created and implemented for the purpose of achieving efficiency and improving workflow. The employee manual and policies were reviewed and revised and monthly budget reports are distributed to department heads. The Employee Recognition Program was implemented to recognize time of service for employees and to show appreciation for their dedication to the town.

## **Communication.**

During the last month of 2018, the town began to utilize the paperless, cloud-based program called Board Docs. In 2019, this program continues to be an efficient tool to help residents stay abreast of meetings without having to be physically present. A new, more efficient phone system was installed to allow quicker communication with staff members.

## **Contracts.**

Implement an annual review policy for all contracts to review effectiveness and performance obligations.

## **Training.**

CPR & First Aid Training. Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Training. The AED was donated by Abigail Francisco. Narcan training was available through the Twin Beach Opioid Awareness Committee.

## **Technology Upgrades.**

Councilman Troncone has taken the lead on the new Information Technology (IT) plan. The plan includes hardware and software upgrades, increased network security and proper inventory of equipment. Having our residents connected to their government is essential and in 2019, work began on the new interactive Citizen Mobile App for zoning and code enforcement issues. With this app, residents will be able to use their smartphones or other digital devices to report issues or concerns in real time. This is expected to be launched in the coming weeks.

## **Calvert Library Twin Beaches Branch.**


The Memorandum of Agreement was signed on October 1, 2019 and the library is currently in the planning phase. The planning is expected to be approximately 18 months. The construction of the new library is expected to take approximately 18 months.

## **Capital Improvements.**

Installed new water meters and constructed new well house under the supervision of the Department of Public Works (DPW). Through our partnership with Calvert County, we are moving forward with the debris clean out of the 8' stormwater pipe to help with storm flooding. To improve our wastewater management, we have installed a new, more efficient pump at the Chesapeake Avenue pump station. With the support of Sustainable Maryland, University of Maryland and Calvert County, North Beach will have its first tidal/stormwater flood plan in place going into 2021.

## **Intergovernmental Relationships.**

Maintain communication and a favorable working relationship with members of our neighboring town of Chesapeake Beach, commissioners and staff from Calvert County and the town's delegation at the State House in Annapolis.

## **Wastewater.**

Stood up quarterly meetings with Chesapeake Beach, Calvert County and Anne Arundel County to improve efficiencies within the wastewater treatment plant to help control the cost to our residents. We improved the shared maintenance agreement of the two wastewater pumping stations between Calvert County and the shared line leading into the plant.

## **Water Conservation.**

We continued to improve strategies to conserve water and prevent water loss among residents and businesses in town.

## **Committees.**

Created the Stormwater and Flood Mitigation Advisory Committee to assist with plans to improve the town's flooding concerns and provide advice and guidance regarding stormwater and coastal flood issues. Reestablished the North Beach Tree Committee to advise the town on maintenance and preservation of trees and shrubs in parks, along streets and in other public areas; and, to promote public awareness and pride in our native trees, observe Arbor Day and move the town forward in becoming a Tree City, USA community.

Net assessable real property base increased from **\$245,941,741** on July 1, 2018 to **\$249,360,825** on July 1, 2019.



Minimum quarterly water and sewer bill remained at a rate of **\$148.20**.



The town's Constant Yield Rate of **0.6292** per 100 of assessed value was proposed but the town adopted a .6329 tax rate.



Healthy Living Grant/Maryland Energy Administration: **\$100,000**.



Trash Rate remained the same at **\$327.00** annually.



Critical Areas Grant: **\$1,900**.

## Healthy Homes Funding

- Savings per household ranged from \$40 to \$1,100 per year depending on services provided.

From May 10 through September 2





As temperatures dip and winter approaches, staying warm and safe can be a challenge. Winter storms can bring cold temperatures, power failures, and icy roads. To keep you and your loved ones safe, you should know how to prepare your home and your car before a winter storm hits. Make a plan, think ahead and utilize the following suggestions:

- get your heating system checked out and perform preventive maintenance;
- protect water lines and crawl spaces from freezing temperatures;
- insulate walls and attic;
- have your chimney or flue inspected each year;
- ensure your vehicle is in good running condition; and,
- perform maintenance and test run any back-up power source you may have.

If you have off-street parking, please use it during a snow event. When the snowplows are clearing the roads, it greatly helps the crews if there are minimal cars in the way. Please refer to the Town Snow Policy on our website at [www.northbeachmd.org](http://www.northbeachmd.org) for additional information.

Another consideration during a snow event is to check the blades of your heat pump while you are outside clearing sidewalks and driveways. The blades cannot withstand a lot of weight from heavy snow. Turn off the unit and clear the blades to ensure it is working properly.



- Replaced approximately 25% of plantings with perennials for annual Plant the Town event.






