5	Develop a Nuisance Flood Plan pursuant to MD law (due October 2020).	Lauren	Have reached out to DNR (Sasha Land) for links to sample plans, link to NFP Powerpoint and to confirm that the Town would like to participate in DNR's program that documents flooding events (a requirement that must be incorporated into the NFP). Sasha has not provided the information but has confirmed that she will soon.
6	Work with DNR (Sasha Land) to procure a flood gauge from USGS. Cost is \$10K. USGS will install the gauge and perform all maintenance. The flood gauge will measure, store and transmit water level as frequently as every 5 minutes. Some gauges have cameras that capture and transmit photos of flood conditions. The gauge can be used by the Town to: inform flood forecasting and emergency response; issue appropriate flood watches/warnings; inform flood management decisions to include infrastructure design; and, establish flood risk zones/mapping.
