1	The application for a DNR grant for \$75,000 to fund development, by EFC, of a comprehensive stormwater and flood plan was submitted by the town. See, https://www.northbeachmd.org/other-documents-and-information . We have heard that we have been approved for the grant but have not received formal notification from DNR. We have also heard that DNR, in conjunction with EFC, is drafting the scope of work. We have asked DNR/EFC for an opportunity to review the scope of work and provide comment before it is finalized. 2	Within the next two months, the Committee will present a formal recommendation to the Mayor and the Town Council for their consideration regarding how each pump should be upgraded, how the upgrades should be prioritized and the timing for each upgrade. The Committee’s recommendation will be based, in part, on what EFC identifies in its draft Scope of Work regarding the three pump stations. It also will be based what the the 5th street developers (commercial and library) agree to do regarding stormwater mitigation for 5th street as well as the schedule for the completion of the raising of 261, which should improve but will not stop the flooding on 7th and 9th streets.
