PRE-REGISTER FOR THE COVID-19 VACCINE ONLINE

Residents age 18 and older may pre-register <u>online</u> at www.calvertcountymd.gov/Vaccine.

PRE-REGISTER FOR THE COVID-19 VACCINE OVER THE PHONE

Call 410-535-0218, Monday through Friday from 7 am. to 7 pm. to pre-register for the vaccine over the phone.

Do not call the Department of Public Works for water/sewer account inquiries or payments or to request a bulk pick up.
