PERMITS

The Zoning Department can process miscellaneous Zoning Permits by email and can process payments over the phone. If you are not sure if your project will require a permit, email rcrump@northbeachmd.org with any questions or concerns. Performing un-permitted work during this crisis is still a violation of town code. Town staff will handle Miscellaneous Zoning Permits as efficiently and expeditiously as possible.
