HEALTH & SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

North Beach, Maryland

Public restrooms are open and maintained from 6 am to 8 pm daily. Restrooms are posted with "Enter at Your Own Risk" signage and are cleaned every two hours. The beaches remain closed at this time.

The town is promoting the following CDC guidelines to help prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- ·Wear mask or face covering in INDOOR PUBLIC settings.
- Signage in OUTDOOR public areas around town say, "Wear a Mask." This is a recommendation, but is not mandatory. Use your best judgement!
- Use hand sanitizer and wash hands.
- •Stay home if you are unwell.

UPDATE TO TRASH, RECYCLE & BULK PICKUP SCHEDULE

Please make note of two changes to the Trash, Bulk and Recycle Schedule:

- Place trash outside the night before pickup days. All trash must be bagged and in a can with a secure lid.
- Bulk pickup is now on the third Friday of each month. Call Town Hall by the Tuesday prior to the monthly pickup date to schedule an appointment for your bulk trash pickup.
