CALLING TOWN HALL

For routine calls or to reach an employee's direct line, remember to call 301.855.6681, press 1 and then press the number that corresponds to the staff member you are trying to reach. To make a payment on your water/sewer account, press 6. To make a bulk pick-up appointment, press 1. Do not call the Department of Public Works for water/sewer account inquiries or payments or to request a bulk pick up.

ACCESS NORTH BEACH: YOUR LINK TO TOWN HALL

Access North Beach allows you to contact town staff directly with your comments, compliments, suggestions or concerns. This program can be accessed from the link on the town website and also can be downloaded from the iPhone and Android app stores. To use Access North Beach, just choose a topic, provide your contact information and enter your question, suggestion, complaint or compliment. It's that easy! Access North Beach should not be used for emergencies. Users must be located in North Beach when submitting a concern. More information at northbeachmd.org.

WHEN THE LEAVES FALL

Please bag or haul away all leaves and yard debris. This will keep debris out of the storm drain collection system and ensure the water flows properly. Once leaves and debris enter the underground piping system, it is very difficult and expensive to remove this type of material. Bagged leaves can be placed with household trash for pick up on Mondays and Fridays.

FREE RESIDENTIAL PAPER SHREDDING EVENTS

SUBMIT MAIL-IN BALLOTS UNTIL NOVEMBER 3

Voters who requested and have received a mail-in ballot can submit their voted ballot in any of these secure drop boxes 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, until November 3 at 8 pm.
