

PARTIAL SOLAR ECLIPSE

April 8, 2024 at 2 pm

Maximum coverage around 3:20 pm

Head to the North Beach Boardwalk to view a partial solar eclipse!

DETAILS FROM THE EXPERTS:









- The eclipse is predicted to begin at 2 pm and end at 4:30 pm, with the maximum coverage around 3:20 pm.
- During the eclipse, there will be about an 87% coverage of the sun. Our area is not in the path of totality so you may notice it getting darker outside, but there will not be total darkness.
- Be safe! Never look directly at the sun without proper eye protection. Do not view the eclipse through sunglasses, a telescope, or binoculars. View the eclipse with special glasses or filters that conform to ISO standards. The Town of North Beach will have solar eclipse glasses available for pick up at Town Hall on Monday, April 8th from 8:30 am to 12 pm. Any remaining glasses will be available at the Welcome Center.
