



PARTIAL SOLAR ECLIPSE

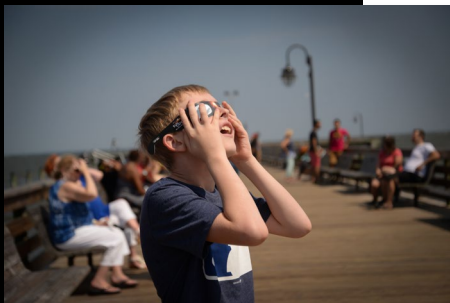
April 8, 2024 at 2 pm

Maximum coverage around 3:20 pm

Head to the North Beach Boardwalk to view a partial solar eclipse!

DETAILS FROM THE EXPERTS:

- The eclipse is predicted to begin at 2 pm and end at 4:30 pm, with the maximum coverage around 3:20 pm.
- During the eclipse, there will be about an 87% coverage of the sun. Our area is not in the path of totality so you may notice it getting darker outside, but there will not be total darkness.
- Be safe! Never look directly at the sun without [proper eye protection](#). Do not view the eclipse through sunglasses, a telescope, or binoculars. View the eclipse with special glasses or filters that conform to ISO standards. **The Town of North Beach will have solar eclipse glasses available for pick up at Town Hall on Monday, April 8th from 8:30 am to 12 pm.** Any remaining glasses will be available at the Welcome Center.
