Open meeting to discuss concept plan for Chesapeake Avenue

- Welcome residents and business owners.
 Thanks for coming out.
- Background When CPAT group came to the Town in August, 2015 to help create a master plan for the Business District one of their suggestions was to create a streetscape plan for Chesapeake Avenue to upgrade the appearance for residents and visitors.

- The town put out an RFP to address this recommendation. In the RFP to the town included streetscape, possibility of new lights and banner poles, pedestrian safety and traffic calming ideas.
- Quotes were received and a firm was selected to create a concept plan to achieve these ideas, at minimum these goals.
- Town staff worked together with CPH and together came up with a concept plan for Chesapeake Avenue that addressed items that had been discussed.











Potential Shade Structure Improvements




- Address tree wells, possible moving of light and banner poles.

- Possibility of improving of intersections.
- Consider using pavers or colored concrete for crosswalks. This would improve looks and act as traffic control. Pavers would act as natural speed bumps.
