

MONITOR AND/OR PAY WATER & SEWER ACCOUNT



Create an online account to monitor your water and sewer activity or to easily pay your quarterly bill. Go to www.northbeachmd.org. Click “Online Payments” and then register your account. You must use the full account number, including the lead zeros. If you encounter an issue setting up your account, contact Town Hall for assistance.

ACCESS NORTH BEACH: YOUR LINK TO TOWN HALL



Access North Beach allows you to contact town staff directly with your comments, compliments, suggestions or concerns. This program can be accessed from the link on the town website and also can be downloaded from the iPhone and Android app stores. To use Access North Beach, just choose a topic, provide your contact information and enter your question, suggestion, complaint or compliment. It's that easy!

TEXT NOTIFICATIONS



Are you interested in receiving text messages about things that may impact you as a resident? We promise not to bombard you with texts! You can subscribe or unsubscribe at any time. Follow the simple instructions below to subscribe to text notifications:

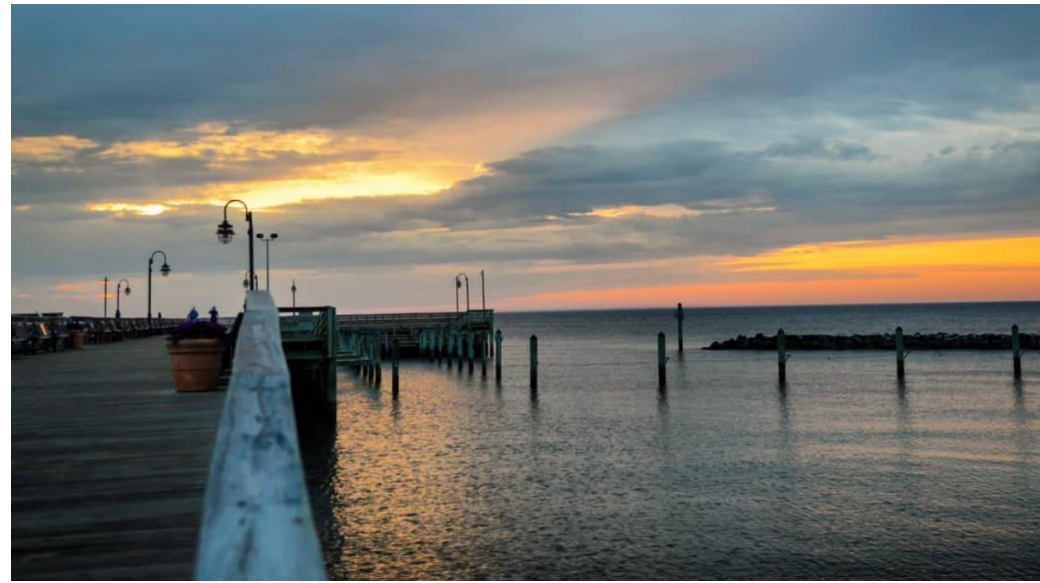
- **VIA TEXT.** In your phone, enter 30890 as the phone number you want to send a text to, and enter the words **join northbeachalerts** in the message area, then hit send.
- **ONLINE SIGNUP.** From the homepage of the town's website, click on **Subscribe to Text Notifications** and follow the steps to add contact details.

Some examples of text notifications are road closures, water shut off for repair, water and sewer payment reminders, hydrant flushing and meeting announcements.

SUBSCRIBE TO E-NEWS



Residents can subscribe to receive informational emails by visiting the town website homepage and click on the **Subscribe to News** link on the home page. You can choose the topic(s) on which you would like to receive emails. After entering your email address and submitting your request, look in your email box for a confirmation email (this might be hidden in your Junk or Spam Folder). Reply to that email to start receiving town emails.

BEACH OPENING



The Town of North Beach has tentative plans to open the beach areas from May 28 through September 6, 2021. In addition to a new online ticketing system where daily passes may be obtained, there will be a reduction in the capacity of guests permitted on the beach and adjusted operating hours. ***Beach access will be unlimited for residents that live within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of North Beach!***

FARMERS' MARKET SEASON



The 2021 North Beach Farmers' Market season is tentatively set for May 1 through September 25, 2021. We are pleased to announce changes to the market that will give it a traditional, small town atmosphere. The new North Beach Farmers' Market will be held on Saturday mornings from 8 to 11 am in the parking lot of the North Beach Senior Center. The market will include local vendors with items such as plants, farm vegetables, baked goods, meats, cheeses, eggs and other fresh goods.

MD RT. 261 IS OPEN



Crews have completed the roadway paving on MD Rt. 261 between the Calvert County/Anne Arundel County line. Guardrails, new roadway signs and temporary pavement markings have also been installed. The roadway was opened on Monday, March 29, 2021. Please remain alert for work crews; there may be times when travelers will encounter a flagging operation between 9 am and 3 pm. during the remainder of the construction project. As project updates are received from MDOT SHA, the Town of North Beach will continue to share with the public via email blast, town website and social media.

BUG OFF



Seasonal mosquito control spraying typically takes place from May through October, as needed. Be sure to empty all containers and dump any standing water in your yard to prevent mosquitoes from breeding. If you hear the spray truck coming, please go inside for a few minutes. The more residents that are off the streets, the more the spray trucks can spray. HEALTHY HOMES PROGRAM



The Healthy Homes program was made possible through funding from the Maryland Energy Administration and was created to assist those most vulnerable, seniors and low-to-moderate income residents. CROSSWALK SAFETY



Warmer weather means there will be more visitors in town. North Beach is pedestrian-friendly so please look out for pedestrians and bicyclists at all times. When approaching crosswalks, intersections and the waterfront areas, reduce your speed and be prepared to stop.

NO BUTTS ABOUT IT: DON'T LITTER



The filters on cigarettes are made of cellulose acetate, a form of plastic that is slow to degrade in the environment. Cigarette butts can take anywhere from 18 months to 10 years to decompose, depending on conditions, and are poisonous to children, pets and wildlife. Cigarette butts are the #1 item found on beaches, roadsides and parks and leach toxic chemicals into the environment. Don't litter!

REGULAR TRASH, RECYCLABLES & BULK PICK-UP



Regular trash must be placed outside the night before pick-up in a visible location in secured plastic bags and placed in trash cans WITH A LID; it is collected on Monday/Friday of each week. Promptly put away empty cans after trash is collected. Recyclables are picked up every Wednesday and must be in a container clearly marked "recycling." Bulk trash is picked up the third Friday of each month, by appointment only. Call Town Hall by the Tuesday prior to the monthly pickup date to schedule an appointment for your bulk trash pickup.
