TEXT NOTIFICATIONS



Are you interested in receiving text messages about things that may impact you as a resident? We promise not to bombard you with texts! You can subscribe or unsubscribe at any time. Follow the simple instructions below to subscribe:

- VIA TEXT. In your phone, enter 30890 as the phone number you want to send a text to, and enter the words join northbeachalerts in the message area, then hit send.
- ONLINE SIGNUP. From the homepage of the town's website, click on Subscribe to Text Notifications and follow the steps to add contact details.

Some examples of text notifications are road closures, water shut off for repair, water and sewer payment reminders, hydrant flushing and meeting announcements.

BEACH ACCESS FOR RESIDENTS



To check in for beach access, town residents may proceed directly to one of the three gates to present their beach pass to the Town Attendant on duty. Residents will then receive wristbands and are able to immediately walk on the beach. Guests must be with you in order to receive their wristbands. This change is an effort to reduce the amount of wait time for access to the beach.

BULK PICK-UP



Bulk trash is picked up on the third Friday of each month. To schedule an appointment, contact the Town Hall by the Tuesday prior to the bulk pick-up to provide a brief description of each item to be picked up. A contact name, street address and phone number must also be provided. Bulk pick up items should not be placed curbside until the evening prior or the morning of the scheduled pick up. The contractor will not pick up any items that are not on the list.

CALVERT LIBRARY TWIN BEACHES BRANCH



Construction activity continues at the site of the new Twin Beaches Branch Library. Contractors have been working on the initial excavation and grading work and utility relocation. The new sewer, water and stormwater utilities have been installed. Once underground wires are relocated, the construction site will be more active. Heads up! The sidewalk on Chesapeake Avenue is closed in front of the construction site. Pedestrians walking on Chesapeake Avenue should cross the street in the crosswalk at 5th Street or 7th Street to avoid walking in the roadway.

MESSAGE FROM NORTH BEACH VFD



Please refrain from parking within 25 feet of all stop signs in town. This will allow emergency vehicles and fire apparatus the ability to navigate around turns when responding to emergencies. Thank you!

SAFETY IN THE HEAT



With the high temperatures of the season, it is recommended that residents use extreme caution while taking part in outdoor activities. Take breaks during your walks, drink plenty of fluids and try to avoid the sun as much as possible. As temperatures rise, so do the temperatures of the boardwalk and asphalt. To help keep dogs free from harm, check how hot the surface is before you and your pup walk on it. If it's too hot for your hand or bare feet, then it's too hot for theirs! Lastly, check on your neighbors and stay cool!

NEW WATER / SEWER BILLING SYSTEM



The Town of North Beach has implemented the new and improved water/sewer billing program, Muni-Link. The Online Payment link on our website has been updated with the information necessary for you to set up your customer portal to pay your bill. Please note that any automatic payments that you had set up previously will need to be changed and/or set up in the new system. Though we are urging all residents to pay their water/sewer bills online, you may also continue to pay your water/sewer bill by mailing a check in the pre-printed envelope that is included with your water bill; dropping off your payment in the lock box outside of Town Hall; or contacting Town Hall to pay over the phone with a credit card. If you have automatic payments being mailed to the P.O. Box in Philadelphia, PA, you will need to send those payments directly to the Town of North Beach at PO Box 99, North Beach, MD 20714.

HANDICAP/DISABILITY PARKING SPACES



"Tm just running in real quick!" "It's raining and this is the closest spot to the door!" These are the excuses we hear when people have parked illegally in the two handicap/disability parking spots in front of the Post Office, which are clearly marked with a stencil painted on the asphalt and signage. Be a good neighbor and only park in these spaces if you are displaying legal/valid handicap/disability tags or placards.

TOWN OF NORTH BEACH ELECTION



The Town of North Beach Election for the position of Mayor and Town Councilmembers will be conducted on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 at Town Hall. Those interested in running for the positions of Mayor (one position) or Town Councilmember (six positions) must be at least 21 years of age and have lived within the incorporated Town limits for six months prior to the election. The Certificate of Candidacy forms must be submitted by Monday, August 29, 2022, by 5:00 pm.
