ACCESS NORTH BEACH: YOUR LINK TO TOWN HALL



Access North Beach allows you to contact town staff directly with your comments, compliments, suggestions or concerns. This program can be accessed from the link on the town website and also can be downloaded from the iPhone and Android app stores. To use Access North Beach, just choose a topic, provide your contact information and enter your question, suggestion, complaint or compliment. It's that easy!

TEXT NOTIFICATIONS



- To receive text messages about things that may impact you as a resident, follow these simple instructions:
- VIA TEXT. In your phone, enter 30890 as the phone number you want to send a text to, and enter the words **join northbeachalerts** in the message area, then hit send.
- ONLINE SIGNUP. From the homepage of the town's website, click on **Subscribe to Text Notifications** and follow the steps to add contact details.

Some examples of text notifications are road closures, water shut off for repair, water and sewer payment reminders, hydrant flushing and meeting announcements.

SUBSCRIBE TO E-NEWS



Residents can subscribe to receive informational emails by visiting the town website homepage / **Subscribe to News** link. Choose the topic(s) on which you would like to receive emails. After entering your email address and submitting your request, look in your email box for a confirmation email. Reply to that email to start receiving town emails.

COVID TESTING & VACCINATIONS



The Calvert County Health Department is doing Covid testing and administering vaccinations at their site at the Fox Run Shopping Center at 713 Solomons Island Rd. North in Prince Frederick.

All tests at the Health Department test site are PCR, which are more reliable than rapid antigen tests. PCR tests are sent to a licensed medical laboratory with results typically available in 1-2 days. Testing hours are Monday-Friday from 9:00 am-1:30 pm and is by appointment only. Information on scheduling an appointment can be found at: https://www.calvertcountycovid19.com/testing-sites Moderna and Pfizer Covid vaccinations will be administered Monday-Friday from 2:30-4:00 pm. One day each week, vaccinations will be given until 6:00 pm. REGULAR TRASH, RECYCLABLES & BULK PICK-UP



Regular trash must be placed outside **the night before** pick-up in a visible location in secured plastic bags and placed in trash cans WITH A LID; it is collected on Monday/Friday of each week. Promptly put away empty cans after trash is collected. **Recyclables** are picked up every Wednesday and must be in a container clearly marked "recycling." **Bulk trash** is picked up the third Friday of each month, by appointment only. Call Town Hall by the Tuesday prior to the monthly pickup date to schedule an appointment for your bulk trash pickup. The full schedule is available at <u>www.northbeachmd.org</u>. WATER BILLING

NEVER POUR GREASE IN YOUR DRAIN



Grease blocks sewer pipes! Never pour grease in your sink drain. When grease washes down the sink, it sticks to the insides of the pipes that connect your home to the town's sewer. It also coats the insides of the town's sewer pipes. Eventually, the grease will build up and can completely block sewer pipes. The blockage can create difficult and expensive maintenance problems for both the town and private property owners. To prevent sewer backups and blockages, please be mindful of what items you are pouring into your sink drains! And, while we have your attention, the only thing you should ever flush down a toilet is human waste (urine and feces) and toilet paper. Please keep in mind, products that are labeled as "flushable" are not sewer friendly and should not be flushed.
