CHESAPEAKE BEACH TRAFFIC DETOUR

NEW TRASH SCHEDULE



The trash schedule for July through December 2023 has been posted on the town website. Printed copies are available at the Post Office and Town Hall. Trash will now be picked up on Tuesday when a holiday falls on Monday. Place bagged trash in cans with a lid and put by the curb the night before each collection date. Recyclables must be in a container clearly marked "recycling." Bulk trash pickup is the third Friday of each month, BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. Call Town Hall (301.855.6681) by the Tuesday prior to the monthly pickup date to schedule an appointment for your bulk trash pickup.

WIPES CLOG PIPES



Can you do us a favor? Please don't flush the wipes... even if the package says they are flushable! Also, don't flush paper towels or napkins! These items cause sewer backups and blockages. The only things that should be flushed down the toilet are human waste (urine, feces, etc.). Our Department of Public Works' staff thanks you!

MONITOR AND PAY WATER & SEWER ACCOUNT



Monitor and pay your water and sewer account with Muni-Link. Though we are urging all residents to pay their water/sewer bills online, you may also continue to pay your water/sewer bill by mailing a check in the pre-printed envelope that is included with your water bill; dropping off your payment in the lock box outside of Town Hall; or contacting Town Hall to pay over the phone with a credit card. CROSSWALK SAFETY



Warmer weather means there will be more visitors in town. North Beach is pedestrian-friendly so always look out for pedestrians and bicyclists. When approaching crosswalks, intersections and the waterfront areas, reduce your speed and be prepared to stop.

SAFETY IN THE HEAT



With the high temperatures of the season, it is recommended that residents use extreme caution while taking part in outdoor activities. Take breaks during your walks, drink plenty of fluids and try to avoid the sun as much as possible. As temperatures rise, so do the temperatures of the boardwalk and asphalt. To help keep dogs free from harm, check how hot the surface is before you and your pup walk on it. If it's too hot for your hand or bare feet, then it's too hot for theirs! Lastly, check on your neighbors and stay cool!
