TEXT NOTIFICATIONS



To receive text messages about things that may impact you as a resident, follow these simple instructions:

- VIA TEXT. In your phone, enter 30890 as the phone number you want to send a text to, and enter the words **join northbeachalerts** in the message area, then hit send.
- ONLINE SIGNUP. From the homepage of the town's website, click on **Subscribe to Text Notifications** and follow the steps to add contact details.

MESSAGE FROM CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICE



The Code Enforcement Office would like to share the following reminders with residents:

- Regular household trash must be bagged and placed in a trash can with a lid. Please place trash cans curbside the night before the collection date and promptly remove cans from the curb once trash has been picked up.
- Utility trailers and commercial vehicles and trucks over 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight are prohibited from parking on all residential and commercial rights-of-way within the Town of North Beach.
- Unregistered, inoperable, wrecked, or dismantled vehicles are not permitted to be parked, stored or left upon any public street, alley, or parking lot within the town.

WATER BILLING

PREVENT BLOCKAGES, BACKUPS & DAMAGE



The Department of Public Works (DPW) routinely checks for issues with town pump stations and sewer system. These checks are a proactive measure to prevent damage to the sewer system and sewer backups. On multiple occasions, DPW staff has found rags, wipes and grease clogging the pumps at pump stations. Please be mindful of what is flushed in your home. When you use your toilet, shower, washing machine or dishwasher, wastewater leaves your home through pipes that connect to the town sewer system. Many materials frequently flushed or poured down the drain can damage the sewer system, cause sewer backups in your home, and sewer releases to the environment. The only thing you should ever flush down a toilet is human waste (urine and feces) and toilet paper. Remember, products that are labeled as "flushable" are not sewer-friendly and should not be flushed.

BULK TRASH PICK-UP



Bulk trash is picked up the third Friday of each month, **by appointment only**. Call Town Hall by the Tuesday prior to the monthly pickup date to schedule an appointment for your bulk trash pickup.
