Take steps to avoid “Identity Theft” by shredding documents that contain your personal information and/or account information. Calvert Count offers FREE shred events every month. For a list of dates, go to <http://www.co.cal.md.us/residents/waste/recycling/>.

In addition, never give your personal information to anyone on an incoming phone call. Remember, institutions where you do business already have your info. If they tell you they want to verify, have them read to you what they have. If they give you incorrect info, do not give them your correct info, simply tell them the information is not correct. Always ask for the full name of the person calling and a call back number before sharing ANY information. ALL valid companies will readily give this information to you upon request. Check the number online to confirm it is a valid call and is going to the company indicated. Then, call the company back or visit in person (i.e. bank). When in doubt, don’t give any info out!
