- 1) Tree bid results for the North Beach Park and Sculpture Garden: Bids were received from five companies. The lowest bid received was from Kelley Tree Service in the amount of \$14,275.00. Donnie Bowen is requesting the award is done at the meeting tonight so the trees can be installed soon. Motion made Randy Hummel to award the contract to Kelley's Tree Service in the amount of \$14,275.00. Seconded by Ken Wilcox. All in favor.
- 2) Beautification Priority with the Economic Development Committee and the Environmental Committee presentation: Guy Stone from the Environmental Committee and Karen Ankerbrandt from the Economic Development Committee gave a joint presentation on a Town Pride Campaign they would like to develop. This campaign would include the purchase of trash cans to be placed along Chesapeake Avenue, signage on buildings that match along with flags residents and business owners can purchase to show their pride in North Beach. The committee's will work closely with Rick to identify older home owners who may have some code enforcement issues at their homes that needs to be addressed, such as painting, removing of debris, etc. A committee can be formed to help the residents on a volunteer basis to complete these tasks at properties. Other organizations could assist with projects in Town such as school kids, Community Service Workers, Boy Scouts and Church Groups. The Mayor has asked the two committees to continue working together and bring a plan back to the Council when it is complete.

The following is the status of activities that are being worked on:

#### USACOE Wetland Revitalization Project

The Corps has not completed the preparation of their design effort plan for Town approval.. We are working with the COE and SHA to get both agencies to coordinate their engineering efforts.

### th Street Flood Mitigation & Living Shoreline Projects

All permits have been issued with the exception of a permit from Anne Arundel County for 80 ft of the living shoreline in their County. We expect the Anne Arundel County approval during the week of May 18<sup>th</sup>. A preconstruction meeting with all the Agencies is to be held on May 18th after which construction can be started. Environmental Concerns will be providing a final schedule at the Preconstruction meeting.

#### New Fishing Platform and Renovations for Town Pier.

Work is progressing on the lower fishing platform and decking. Don Bowen will provide more detail on the Contractor's schedule in his report.

#### Zoning Ordinance & Map

The Planning Commission continues their work on the draft Ordinance.

#### Bay Front Park

Don Bowen's report will cover current progress at the Park. I am working on updating the stormwater management design to accommodate the final grading work.

#### Drainage & Roadway Projects

We are working on a design for a project to improve the drainage on the east side of Erie Ave. between First & Second Streets in addition developing cost estimates and preliminary plans for capital projects to be considered in the next Town budget cycle.

We are also working on the design for Storm drain out fall Improvements at 7th Street in the vicinity of Atlantic Ave.

#### Maryland SHA Rt. 261 Upgrade Project.

SHA conducted a a progress meeting on their feasibility Study on April 14<sup>th</sup>. They continue to analyze different approaches to raising the road and making roadway improvements for both vehicles and pedestrians (bicycles also). The feasibility Study is scheduled to be completed by this fall.

#### Solar Panel Project DPW Shop Building.

The State finally approved the contract with Solar Tech and Don Bowen is working with the Contractor on getting the work underway.

Subject: Monthly Report

The following is a list of items the Public Works Department has been working on in addition to routine task.

- 1) Had a pre construction meeting with Solar Tech, the firm that was awarded the contract for the installation of solar panels and related equipment on the Public Works building. Solar Tech is obtaining permits from Calvert County and will start as soon as they have permits in hand. Project should be completed within four weeks after installation has started. Solar Tech will provide a monitoring system so we can see net gain in energy.
- 2) Have been busy this month at the park site. Concrete contractor has installed 75% of sidewalks at the site. The remaining was not done so we can access the site without damaging the sidewalks with equipment needed to complete other phases of the park. Retaining wall has been completed. Site grading has been done and is close to finish grade in most areas. Pond plantings have been installed. Water lines are in and connected. Irrigation main lines have been installed and will be completed when trees and landscaping is installed. DPW has built bio retention filter and is ready to be planted. Trees are scheduled to be planted next week.
- 3) Fishing pier contractor is working hard to finish up pier and have it ready to open for the holiday week end. Most of framing and decking is completed, there will be a punch list started for this portion next week. Contractor is in the process of cleaning up the beach and parking lot site this week. Clean up should be completed early next week. Lights for the pier are at DPW shop and K and H are scheduled to install next week. Benches will be placed once lights are in. There was a problem with some of the new decking on the pier that is being addressed by the supplier. This issues will hopefully be completed this week.

- 4) The town has obtained pricing for the cleaning of the storm drain system located in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> street areas. Just received second quote today. Need to go over quotes with staff for this work and have a recommendation for the Mayor and council for the June meeting.
- 5) Have had a couple of onsite meetings with Environmental Concerns about the Living shoreline and flood dike projects. Contractor is working with Mr. Hoffman on remaining details and expected to start work in the coming weeks. A pre constructing meeting is scheduled for 5-18-2015 at the site.



Ipe (Handroanthus spp.)



Common Name(s): Ipe, Brazilian Walnut, Lapacho

Scientific Name: Handroanthus spp. (formerly placed in the Tabebuia genus)

Distribution: Tropical Americas (Central and South America); also farmed commercially

Tree Size: 100-130 ft (30-40 m) tall, 2-4 ft (.6-1.2 m) trunk diameter

Color/Appearance: Heartwood can vary in color from reddish brown, to a more yellowish olive brown or darker blackish brown; sometimes with contrasting darker brown/black stripes. In certain species, there are powdery yellow deposits within the wood. Ipe can be difficult to distinguish visually from Cumaru, another dense South American timber, though Ipe tends to be darker, and lacks the subtle yet characteristic vanilla/cinnamon scent while being worked.

Grain/Texture: Has a fine to medium texture, with the grain varying from straight to irregular or interlocked. Moderate natural luster.

Endgrain: Diffuse-porous; solitary and radial multiples; medium to large pores in no specific arrangement, moderately numerous to numerous; tyloses and mineral/gum deposits occasionally present; parenchyma Interested in getting the Wood Database in print?

Rot Resistance: Rated as very durable; excellent insect resistance, though some species are susceptible to marine borers. Superb weathering characteristics. (Ipe was used for the boardwalk along the beach of New York City's Coney Island, and was said to have lasted 25 years before it needed to be replaced: an amazing lifespan given the amount of traffic and environmental stresses put upon the wood.)

Workability: Overall, Ipe is a difficult wood to work, being extremely hard and dense, with high cutting resistance during sawing. Ipe also has a pronounced blunting effect on cutting edges. The wood generally planes smoothly, but the grain can tearout on interlocked areas. Also, Ipe can be difficult to glue properly, and surface preparation prior to gluing is recommended. Straight-grained wood turns well, though the natural powdery yellow deposits can sometimes interfere with polishing or finishing the wood.

Odor: Ipe has a mild scent while being worked.

Allergies/Toxicity: Although severe reactions are quite uncommon, Ipe has been reported to cause skin, eye, and respiratory irritation, as well as other effects such as headaches, asthma-like symptoms, and/or disturbance of vision. See the articles Wood Allergies and Toxicity and Wood Dust Safety for more information.

**Pricing/Availability:** Primarily sold as decking or flooring, boards for furniture or general use are sometimes availabe as well. Prices are moderate for an imported tropical species.

Sustainability: This wood species is not listed in the CITES Appendices or on the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species. However, Ipe species grow in very low densities, with mature trees only occurring once per 300,000 to 1,000,000 square feet (3 to 10 hectares) of forest area. This necessitates the clearing of large sections of rainforest trees (most of which are of little commercial value). Though uncommon, certified sources of Ipe are available.

**Common Uses:** Flooring, decking, exterior lumber, veneer, tool handles, and other turned objects.

Comments: Ipe is a wood of extremes: extremely dense and durable, as well as extremely difficult to work. Its incredible hardness and strength make it well suited for flooring applications, though it is referred to as "Brazilian Walnut" among flooring dealers—though it is not related to true Walnut in the Juglans genus.
