# Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

• Mayor Benton called the Town of North Beach Mayor and Town Council Work session for June 1, 2023, to order at 7:00 PM.

### **Town Parking Discussion Ideas**

- Mayor Benton started the meeting with a brief description of the proposed parking changes for discussion tonight. He emphasized the need to gain additional parking spaces, improve safety, signage improvement, and education for residents and visitors regarding parking in North Beach. This is the start of a conversation to update the parking regulations.
- Rick Crump, Zoning Administrator presented a PowerPoint presentation explaining the suggested traffic driving directions on 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> streets to gain additional parking spaces between Bay Avenue and Chesapeake Avenue.
- Councilmember Hummel suggested a couple of items to consider for parking; a) a loading zone on 7<sup>th</sup> Street in front of Mexico for all the businesses to utilize; reviewing streets which should have curbs and sidewalks.

- Councilmember Wilcox mentioned discussions held in the past regarding turning 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between Chesapeake and Dayton into a one-way street with angled parking.
- Councilmember Dotson recommended earmarking all monies received for Highway User Revenue to this project. He reminded everyone we absolutely have to go above and beyond to present to the residents the plans.
- Councilmember Kabler suggested extending the study to Annapolis and Atlantic Avenue. She asked for the estimated monetary value of this project.
- Councilmember Healey was also going to ask about the cost of the project. She is looking forward to moving forward with this project.
- Mayor Benton will be sending out an email on Monday regarding the parking discussion.
